CONFAGRI PT integrated the information received from the partners in M21. Some information about these lists will be included in D2.4. The regulatory framework list D5.1 will also be uploaded into the platform (M24).







### 2.1. Deliverable Regulatory Framework

The Regulatory Framework deliverable intends to collect existing information on specific legislation for training, as well as other legislation that will be considered relevant to the main areas of impact of the project (sustainability, digitalization and the bioeconomy in agriculture), taking into consideration the foreseeable future needs for skills in these areas.

A database for the Regulatory Frameworks was created in the FIELDS platform (<u>http://www.erasmus-fields.eu/management</u>). All involved partners uploaded the relevant information related to their domain in two phases: a first phase till the end of August 2021 and, then, a second phase till November 2021, revising the information inserted.

This collection was organised through a table that included thirteen columns for collecting basic information, related with the specific Regulation for training:

- 1. Organisation (combo box) The partner that fills the fields
- 2. Document Reference The name of the regulation in its native language
- 3. Doc\_Type Document type, **in English**, for example, EU law (treaties, legal acts, consolidated texts, international agreements, preparatory documents, summaries of EU legislation), EU case-law (case law, digital reports), national law or regulation etc.
- 4. Framework (combo box) Theme of the regulation (Training / Bioeconomy / Sustainability / Digitalisation)
- 5. Country Which country or geographic area the information refers to
- Keywords related with the information, including the topics of the trends identified in D 1.8, such as Climate Change, Water management, Integrated Pest Management, Organic farming, Biodiversity, Fertilisers, Forestry, Waste management, Animal Welfare, Renewable Energy, Bioenergy, Energy consumption, Packaging, Food Traceability, Food regulations, Technology (robot, drone, etc.), Logistics, E-commerce, E-marketing
- 7. Date Publication date of the document
- 8. Summary Synthesis of the regulation
- 9. Application National, Regional, EU or other
- 10. Entry force Date of the documents' entry into force
- 11. Language Language available of the document (English and/or others)

13. Comments – Any observations the partner wishes to add, besides the information filled in the "Summary" column, that can relate the document with the scoop of the project.

# 3. Results

## 3.1. List of regulatory frameworks


The List of Regulatory Frameworks includes 152 entries, 22% of which refer to EU initiatives and the others constitute national or regional regulatory frameworks from 10 countries (Austria, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia and Spain), as shown in the Graph 1.

Although each partner was incentivised to compare the entries on the regulatory framework identified by other partners, in order to check if there was any other framework to add for its own country, in the final list it is clear that some opted for just listing the big baseline frameworks while others included additional frameworks considered important. One country may have a number of regulatory frameworks






bundled together in one big framework. Another country might have the same frameworks listed separate.

The Categories "Training" (52) and "Sustainability" (40) were the most listed among the regulatory frameworks identified (Graph 2) and most of the regulatory frameworks listed are of national application (102).



Graph 2 - Number of Regulatory Frameworks identified by Theme


Italy is the country with the most regional regulatory framework identified (12 out of 16) in four themes (Agri-business, Bioeconomy, Sustainability and Training).



# 4. Concluding remarks

The list of regulatory frameworks identified is a work in progress, as new legislation still can come into force during the rest of the duration of the project. Partners are incentivised to update the list. However, it is already an important baseline tool that can be useful for future project tasks / activities. It can be used, p.e., to compare what is set in each country and that could be also important in other(s), to identify any European / country framework that is missing or can be proposed.

The regulatory framework may help to identify gaps in training areas that can be proposed for future projects.
